

Rescue and reintegration numbers make Destiny Rescue history

Record-breaking weeks occurred, with over 200 survivors rescued in just one week. With 2,386 rescues, this can be broken down to an average of seven rescues a day. With 1,116 survivors entering community care and 96 coming to live in our residential homes, we're thrilled to see reintegration programming transforming so many lives.



Food drops bring hope and save lives

Monthly food packs providing vital grocery supplies secured freedom for kids who had been forced to sell their bodies to feed their families and enabled rescue agents to find and rescue even more children from exploitation within these communities. In one nation, food drops were given across 250 villages. One food drop alone rescued 141 children.



Online task forces defy Covid-19 obstacles

This year, many survivors were found through social media, where pimps were marketing and selling them to clients. In multiple rescue nations, we saw social media play a larger role in sex trafficking. In proactive response, teams of rescue agents have intentionally been honing online rescue efforts to find kids.

We praise God for His faithfulness. Together, we experienced an unforgettable year with thousands of lives transformed and protected. Let's continue fighting for kids, with the vision of rescuing 100,000 by 2030.

ONLINE COVERT OPERATIONS IN THAILAND

Of the 95 survivors rescued in Thailand, 46 were discovered online by rescue agents. Of the survivors, 74 entered our community care program and have enrolled in school or vocational training.

[RESCUE HIGHLIGHT]

Two friends were rescued together, and both pursued computer studies as a part of their freedom plans.

30 RAIDS IN THE PHILIPPINES

These raids resulted in 251 rescues. Of the survivors, 13% were male, and 47 perpetrators were arrested!

[RESCUE HIGHLIGHT]

Against all odds during a monsoon, two simultaneous raids successfully rescued 12 people, including five girls ages 13 to 16.

HUNDREDS RESCUED IN FIRST YEAR IN UGANDA

Agents rescued 443 survivors; 99% were children. Every child entered our reintegration programs, participating in counseling, attending school or vocational training and learning about God through discipleship classes.

[RESCUE HIGHLIGHT]

In one week, 17 girls, ages five to 17, were rescued. One 12-year-old child was enduring sexual abuse by older classmates in exchange for money to purchase school supplies.

EVERY SURVIVOR ENTERED REINTEGRATION **PROGRAMMING IN**

CAMBODIA Of 53 rescued survivors, 43 entered community care, and 10 entered residential care. Amazingly, 77% of survivors were found in dangerous sex industry locations but were rescued before

[RESCUE HIGHLIGHT]

Sisters, ages 15 and 17, were rescued and enrolled in salon training.

771 RESCUES IN NEPAL

With five newly added border stations in 2021, over 21,000 interviews were conducted across 15 border stations. This resulted in 721 border interception rescues, even with an eight-week border shut down due to Covid-19!

[RESCUE HIGHLIGHT]

A new border station rescued a 17-year-old experiencing sexual abuse. girl during its first week of operation.

BOYS RESCUED IN THE DOMINICAN REPUBLIC

Of 94 rescues, about 33% of survivors were male, the 1000% more kids were largest percentage of boys among all rescue nations. The average age of child survivors was 12 years old.

[RESCUE HIGHLIGHT]

A rescue agent created a "famous" rap artist persona to catch a 26-year-old man who kidnapped and was sexually abusing a 14-year-old girl.

1000% CHILD **RESCUE INCREASE IN UNDISCLOSED NATION**

rescued in 2021 than in 2020. With 652 rescues, 97% entered reintegration programming. Girls as young as eight and nine were rescued who were enduring the horrors of sexual exploitation in order to provide food for their families.

[RESCUE HIGHLIGHT]

Agents rescued a 14-year-old orphaned girl working at a hard labor job and enduring sexual exploitation to survive. She came to live in our residential home.
