A LETTER FROM JASON TASH

CEO, DESTINY RESCUE USA

Who comes down the road next changes everything

"Who comes down the road next changes everything." This powerful truth lies at the heart of our mission, mirrored in the parable of the Good Samaritan. When a traveler was ambushed, beaten and left for dead, those who passed by affirmed his position as a forgotten victim. But when the Samaritan arrived, his compassionate act changed the entire story.

Today, we face a global wound that cries out for the same compassion: the trafficking and sexual exploitation of children. Thanks to your profound commitment, the person who came down the road for 4,177 survivors in 2024 was not another abuser, but a Rescue Agent.

Stepping onto the "Jericho Road"

In 2024, our community of "Good Samaritans" (committed Rescue Partners, compassionate churches, generous donors, passionate advocates and philanthropic foundations) came down the "Jericho Road" with us, bringing rescue and freedom to children. You chose to kneel beside those who had lost everything, taking from your resources to secure their immediate safety and empower bright futures.

This impact was realized through relentless operations. Your generous actions fundamentally changed their path. As one 12-year-old survivor from Kenya shared, *"I thought I was going to die. Thanks for saving my life."*

Beyond the "Jericho Road"

Rescue is the first step, but freedom requires a sustainable future. Like the Samaritan who ensured all future needs would be met, your support extends far beyond the moment of rescue, making healing and possibility real for thousands of children.

Vocational Training	469 survivors pursued new skills training.	
Entrepreneurship	131 businesses were opened or expanded, empowering economic independence.	
Sustainable Freedom	85% of survivors reported being free from exploitation two years after rescue.	

Because of you and your generosity, each rescue is a whisper of hope—*"You are seen. You are worthy. You are not forgotten"*. This hope intersects with their strength and resilience, opening new life-giving roads.

Raids are rescue operations performed in partnership with local law enforcement.

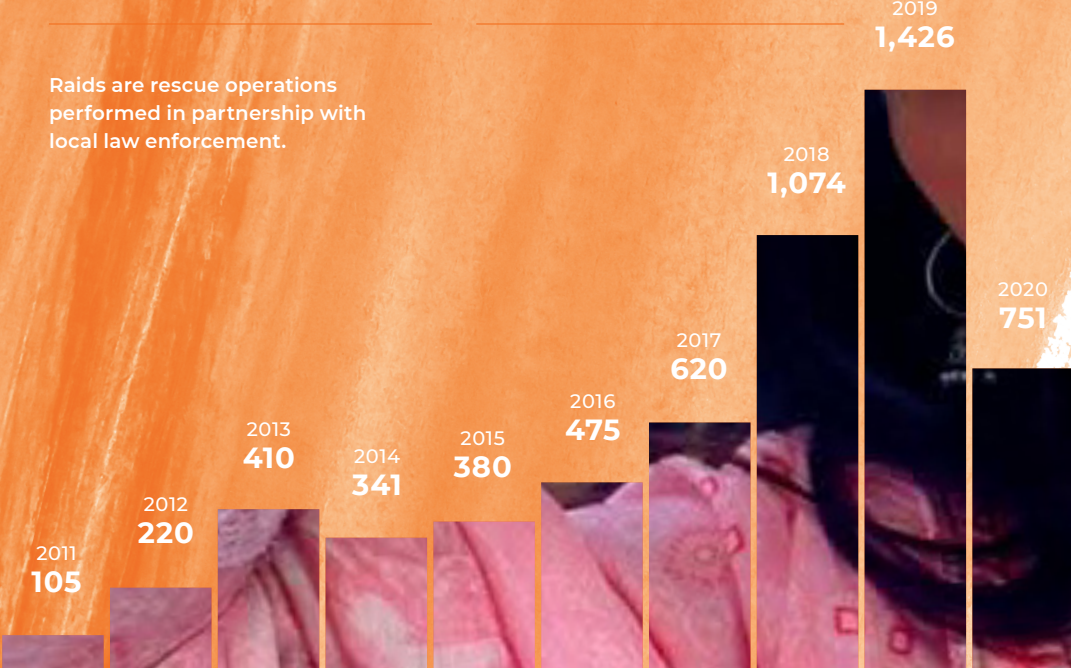

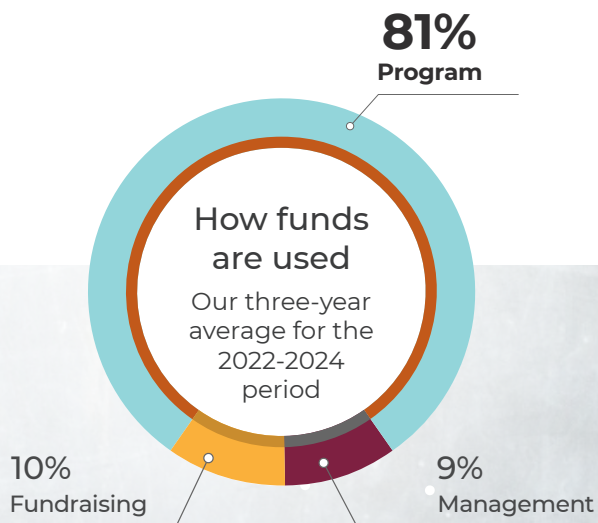

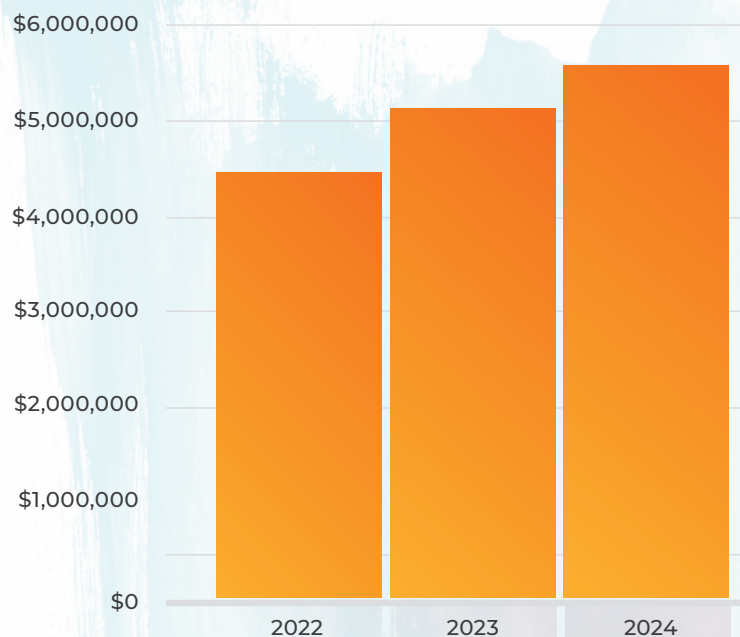
